



Criteria for Selection of Registered Charities

The mandate or main goal of The Manitoba Moose Yearling Foundation is to strengthen and broaden the base of the Manitoba Moose Hockey Club's involvement in the community. It succeeds in this area by providing funds to local, registered children's organizations strictly in the Province of Manitoba.

Designation of funds:

Major Charities - funds given not to exceed more than \$20,000, and will be for a one year period.

Minor Charities - funds given not to exceed more than \$5,000 and will also be for a one year period.

Note: Charities may apply for grants each year. Final decision on applications will be at the Board's discretion.

Guidelines for selection of Recipient Charities:

- ♣ All funds must stay in the Province of Manitoba
- ♣ All charities must be a registered charity in the Province of Manitoba
- ♣ Grants should go towards specific projects, not salaries and/or operating expenses
- ♣ The charities should focus on child and youth programs that provide opportunities which they may not have without these organizations
- ♣ Charities must be prepared to give the appropriate recognition to the Yearling Foundation through:
 - 1) Displaying the Moose and YF logos where applicable
 - 2) Participation and support at YF fundraising events, and if possible, Manitoba Moose hockey games
